Hundreds of lovely roses line the Wilbourne Antique Rose Trail, a public walking trail that winds through the heart of Foley, following the path of the old railroad line. Antique roses, which are disease resistant and well suited to our subtropical climate, are presented in chronological order with signage that identifies each plant species and the year it was propagated.

The City of Foley invites you to walk the rose trail and enjoy the beauty and fragrance of heritage roses. Roses are in bloom during all but the coldest months of the year, and the natural beauty of the gracefully landscaped trail is inspiring all year long.

he Wilbourne Antique Rose Trail follows the route of the Louisville and Nashville railroad into downtown Foley. Access the trail at E. Violet Ave., one-half block east of Hwy. 59, just north of Heritage Park. Enjoy the beauty and fragrance of hundreds of disease-resistant roses, displayed in a variety of sizes and colors. At E. Orchid Ave. the trail continues north for six blocks as a gracefully landscaped walking trail, showcasing native plants, flowers and grasses. A southern section of the rose trail begins south of the U.S. Post Office, and continues to E. Myrtle Ave.
